Ken, Randy, and Dori,

Thank you again for your time and energy for the past several weeks.

I spoke with Tom this afternoon.

First, Tom is supportive and enthusiastic regarding the "school" site. Thus, as long as the City can acquire title to the site without any strings attached, we would be happy on that site. Obviously, we are concerns about the timeline and the number of parties that must engage on this site, but you have our full support.

Second, Tom reiterated his belief that Sid Cash will engage immediately and forcefully if requested by the City. The only concern is ensuring that Mr. Cash is not asked to rally support within his athletic community unless/until MLK becomes the "preferred" site.

In sum, we are fully supportive of both the "school" site and the MLK site. We defer to your judgment.

Third, I alerted Tom to the Monday meeting and reminded him that this will likely be a high profile matter that hits the media in both Orange County and Brevard County.
