As you are likely aware, we are at a crossroads in Winter Park with regard to historic preservation. The Capen House situation has underscored the vital need for a stronger historic preservation ordinance in our city—so that each time one of our precious architectural assets is threatened, it's not incumbent on private citizens to raise hundreds of thousands of dollars to save it. While we are delighted that such a solution has come forward for the Capen House, and continue to urge your support of this project, the greater lesson can't be overlooked: the City of Winter Park has a responsibility to its citizens to protect the culture and heritage that define it and enhance the quality of life for the current and future generations.

Tomorrow evening (Thursday) at 7:00 p.m., consultant Myles Bland will present his recommendations for how the city of Winter Park should strengthen its historic preservation ordinance. This report is a result of the City Commission's charging the Historic Preservation board with making recommendations for improving the ordinance that protects Winter Park's historic structures, in the wake of the Capen House crisis. It is expected that this report will inform the HP Board's recommendations to the city commission.
